We have become aware that some of our members have received fraudulent texts just like this one. The text message goes on to ask you to call a phone number. If you call, the person answering the phone asks for your card number, your Social Security number, PIN number for your card, etc.

We would like to take this opportunity to remind everyone during this holiday season that because they might be using their cards more often, financial institutions and card processors may indeed reach out to them to verify specific transactions but should never ask for any personal information or card numbers etc.

If you are ever contacted by anyone by text or over the phone and you are not sure who you are communicating with, please do not give out any personal information. Hang up and call us directly to inquire.



ESFCU card services supervisor, Micaela Hinerman had this to say. "The holidays are an especially busy time for shoppers but they're also a busy time for those attempting to steal your information. We all need to have a constant awareness of the value of our personal information and take all of the precautions possible to ensure the security of that information."
